



APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL TEACH GRANT

The TEACH Grant provides grant assistance to students who are completing coursework to begin a career in teaching in a high-need field, and who sign an Agreement to Serve. The award is up to \$4,000 per year with a maximum of \$16,000 for an undergraduate degree and \$8, 000 for a graduate degree.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- File a 2008-2009 FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov using AU's school code **003012**
- Submit the Application for TEACH Grant to the AU Financial Aid Office (see address below)
- If eligible for TEACH Grant based on an ACT/SAT subtest score at or above the 75th percentile, submit a copy of your test results to the Financial Aid Office
- Sign an Agreement to Serve at www.teach-ats.ed.gov
- Complete Entrance Counseling (instructions will be forthcoming)
- Complete above processes by October 1, 2008.

I understand that I must plan to TEACH full time in a high-need field in a low-income (Title I) elementary or secondary school, and I must plan to TEACH as a highly qualified teacher for four years within the eight years immediately following completion of the degree.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If the recipient of a TEACH Grant does not fulfill the requirements of the Agreement to Serve, the amount of the entire TEACH Grant converts into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan, with interest retroactive to the date the grant was disbursed.
